WHO WE ARE



Mayaa Hong Kong is a government recognized charity that traces its origins back to 2011 and the creation of Mayaa Nepal. The latest chapter in a long history of charitable endeavours set up by **Nicole Sicard**, a retired biology

teacher who has spent her life educating children in Hong Kong and elsewhere. Our aim is to help children achieve a better standard of living through education. With a team of 8 people including social workers and medical staff in our dedicated centre in Nepal, we are now developing these actions in Hong Kong.

EDUCATION



Our main focus. For families who have trouble feeding themselves, this is a secondary option. Our social workers identify families in the direst need and offer to provide the extras needed for the children to go to school; uniforms,

books, stationary. We currently support **300** children in Nepal and **100** in Hong Kong.

HEALTH

Mayaa Nepal organises monthly health camps in some of the poorest districts of Kathmandu. Free and open to all, these are run by a doctor, a dentist or a gynaecologist. Up to **500** people attend each session meaning we treat up to

4000 people each year, often identifying illnesses that can be treated before they become chronic.

KINDERGARTEN



So that older siblings can attend school and allowing the **mothers** to go out to work, we have set up kindergartens. Run by one of our social workers it currently has some **40** children. These children are already autonomous, and can

start learning in a safe and clean environment, where we provide them with a daily **nutritious meal**.

FAMILY SUPPORT



Our social workers work closely in the community **identifying** families most in need. But they also educate, covering subjects such as basic **hygiene**, money management, the dangers of alcohol and drug abuse as well as prevention

of domestic violence.
